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STATUS OF THE PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION



Under implementation:

- 4 Pre-defined Projects
- 24 Projects under 4 Measures implemented through open calls
- Small Grant Scheme: Scholarship Programme for Roma students of health professions

PRE-DEFINED PROJECTS

ACHIEVEMENTS & RESULTS (1)



PDP 1 „Improving control and information systems in risk prevention and healthcare“

Developed description of the architecture, processes, and modules for three Registries - for Diabetes, Rare Diseases and Sources of Electromagnetic fields

PDP 2 „Improving the surveillance of vaccine-preventable diseases: Development of a model of a web-based immunization registry“

Development of a software model of web-based immunization in progress; Data entry for immunizations and pilot testing of the software model started; Training for work with the model of immunization register conducted

PRE-DEFINED PROJECTS ACHIEVEMENTS & RESULTS (2)



PDP 3 „Improved mental health care services“

Development and implementation of educational programs for early detection of depression and anxiety in primary care – a partial methodological guideline developed; web portal for on-line training created; training (on-line and seminars) started: 2252 persons passed on-line training. 40 seminars were held.

PDP 4 “Improved quality of prenatal diagnosis and neonatal care in Bulgaria”

Public procurement procedure on purchase of equipment for neonatal care units in 28 Bulgarian districts announced and evaluation of offers is ongoing; selection of contractors - by the end of June 2016; Public Procurement on training of specialists in fetal morphology under preparation.

SMALL GRANT SCHEME



SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME FOR ROMA STUDENTS OF HEALTH PROFESSION

100 students received financial support for the academic year 2015/2016.

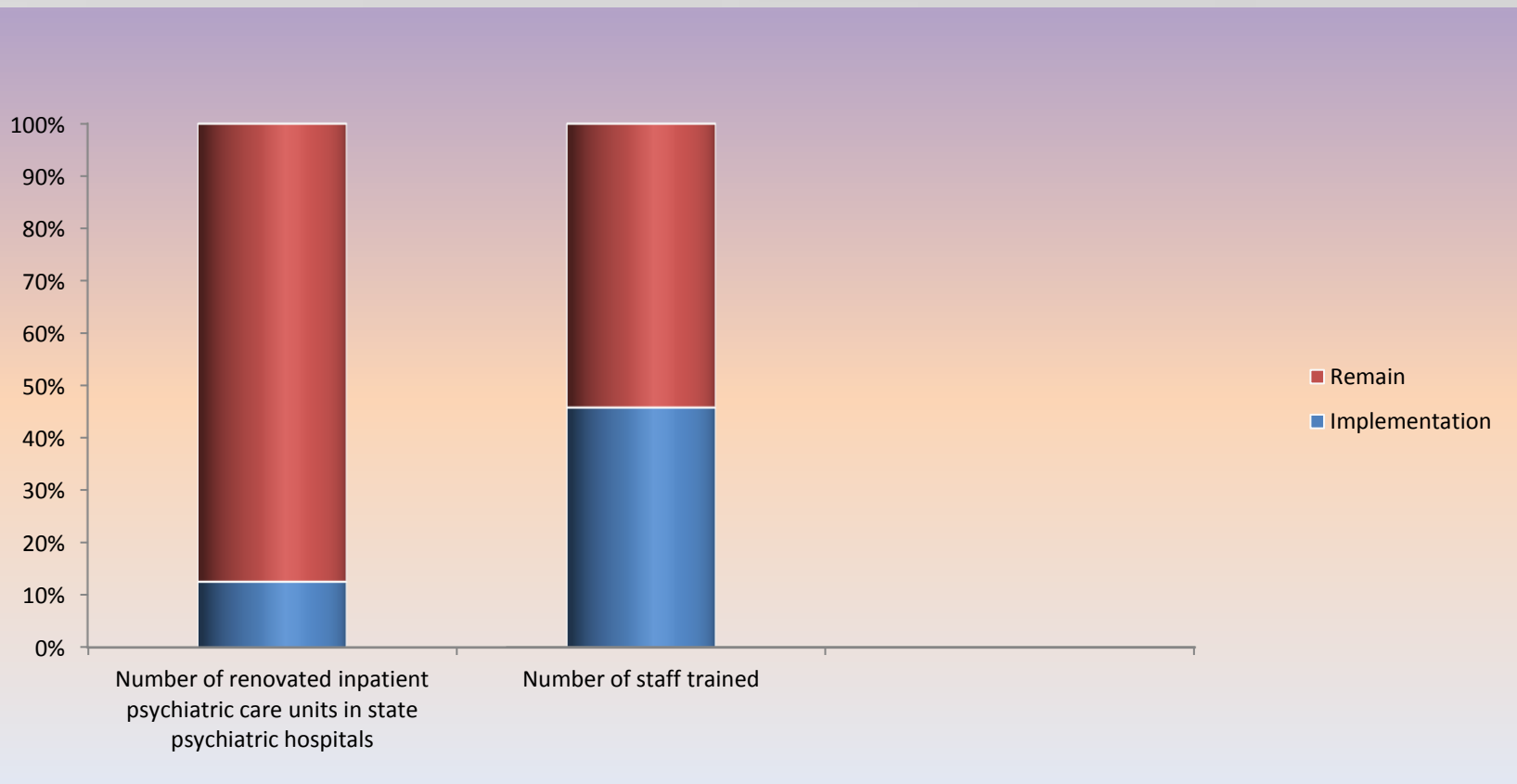
Training on advocacy during a summer camp in May 2016 aimed at developing skills of defending and promoting Roma identity.

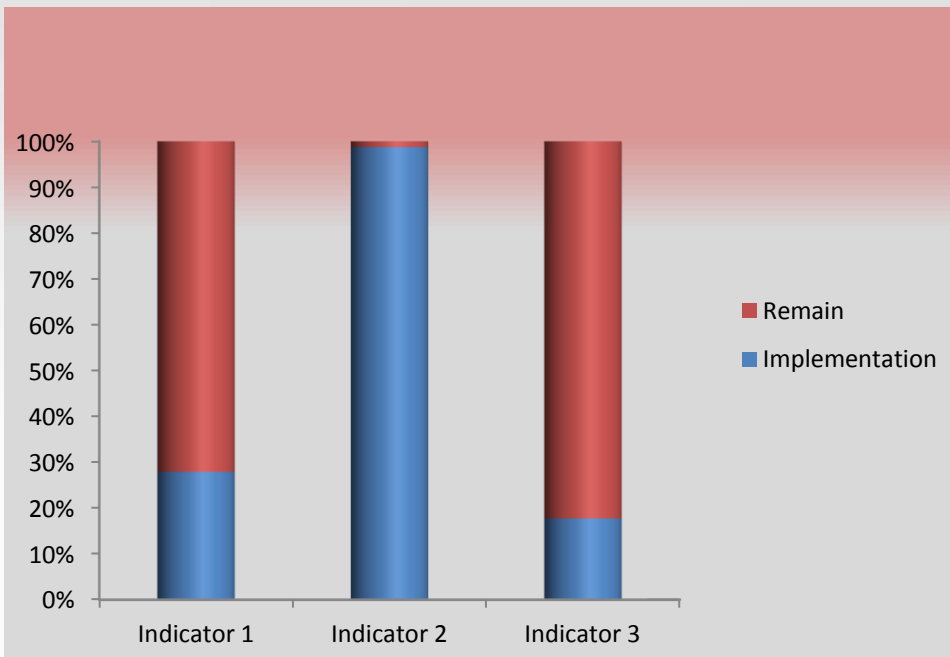
Improvement of the mental health care system

Improved access to quality sexual and reproductive health services for adolescent (19 years old) and other vulnerable groups

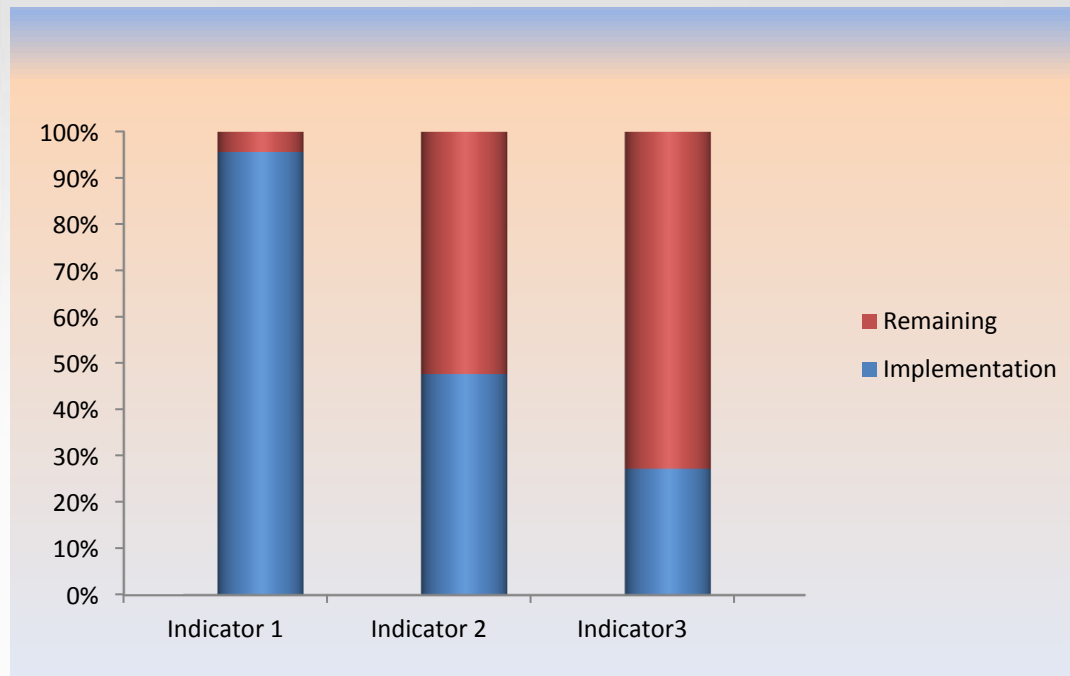


- 1 - Number of young people tested for STI

Improving the quality of and access to health care of children with mental, infectious and genetic diseases, onco-haematological diseases

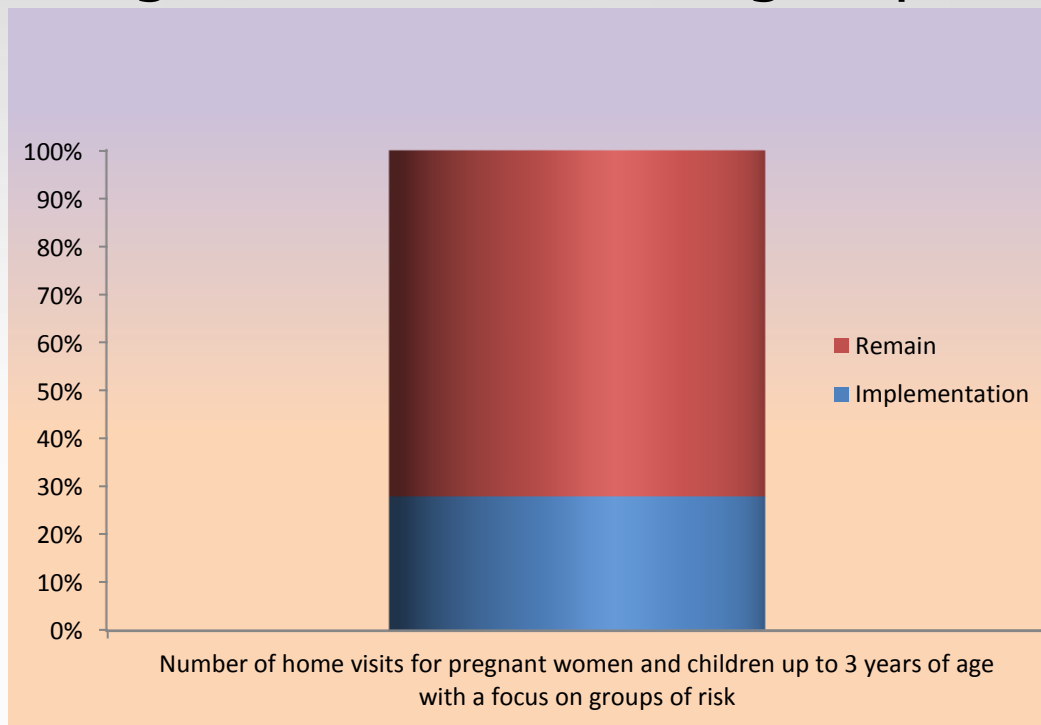


- 1 - Number of trained medical professionals and other care givers

MEASURES IMPLEMENTED THROUGH OPEN CALLS (4)



Delivery of health services through a homecare approach to pregnant women and children up to 3 years of age with a focus on groups at risk



CHALLENGES



- Solution for a good approach in terms of ensuring both absorption and strategic use of funds: combination of pre-defined activities and direct invitation to the PP of all projects under BG07
- Overcoming difficulties in finding partners
- Ensuring of publicity for successful implementation of the programme and the projects is a high priority for PO at the final concluding stage.

LESSONS LEARNED AND PLANNING FOR THE NEXT PERIOD



- Ensure continuity and long-term social impact and sustainability of the results
- A large-scale and important at national level project to be implemented in close cooperation with a donor state partner will have more expressive impact on the health system rather than many small projects

PROJECTS' ACHIEVEMENTS AND RESULTS (1)



Integrated support: enhancement of the access of children with diseases in Sofia, Pernik and Kyustendil to rehabilitation and development of the quality of care for them

Project promoter: Hanna Foundation, Bulgaria

Partner: Institute of Applied Behavior Analysis, Norway (Institutt for anvendt afterdsanalyse, Stavanger)

Project objective: Improvement of the access to and quality of care for children with cerebral palsy, cardiologic diseases and psychic diseases

Total project cost: 192 213 EUR; grant: 172 992 EUR.

PROJECTS' ACHIEVEMENTS AND RESULTS (2)



Progress and main results:

- Establishment of a new Centre for children with disabilities started
- Introduction of 2 new for Bulgaria instruments in the methodology for work with the children and their families (Strange Situation Test to assess the attachment (SST) and the method of conductive pedagogy for rehabilitation of children with cerebral palsy (Petö))
- Training of specialists. Training for families on rehabilitation at home, communication, better care, etc.
- Presentation in media of the possibilities of applied behavior analysis to support children with psychological and mental problems
- Norwegian partner proposes future cooperation

FRESH START FOR YOUNG PEOPLE WITH ANOREXIA AND BULIMIA



- **Project promoter:** Foundation "Center INSIGHT", Bulgaria
- **Partner:** Counselling for eating disorders - ROS - Rådgivning om spiseforstyrrelser, Norway
- **Project objective:** To improve the access to quality treatment services for psychic health and to improve the quality of care for young people with eating disorders (anorexia, bulimia and others) in Bulgaria
- **Total project cost:** 202 000 EUR; grant: 181 800 EUR.
- **Achievements & Results:** Trainings of Bulgarian specialists for early interventions and prevention of eating disorders; Lectures in 12 high schools for acquainting with the disease eating disorders, first symptoms and the ways for mutual help; 3 TV broadcastings; 2 radio broadcastings; 2 publications in newspapers; 1 film under preparation; Anonymous consultation line available; Training by ROS for the multidisciplinary team; Information campaign; Anonymous survey - screening to assess the problem of eating disorders.
