Definitions, Sources and Methods

Immunisation against Hepatitis B

Percentage of children under one year old who have received three doses of hepatitis B vaccine in a given year.

Note: The age of complete immunisation differs across countries due to different immunisation schedules. Immunisation against Hepatitis B is mandatory in certain countries while it is only optional in others (e.g. Canada and France among others).

- Data series completed with WHO/UNICEF Estimates of National Immunization Coverage (WUENIC), marked as estimates (E).
